Pray

before reading, asking God to help you understand and receive his Word. Through Christ you are in the Father's holy presence. Approach him boldly, humbly, and expectantly.

Read

carefully the Bible passage for the day. Refer to the preceding and following sections as necessary, so that you read in context.

Reflect on what you have read, waiting in openness, ready to obey God's Word to you. First, think through the passage, asking yourself such questions as:

- What is the main point of this portion?
- What does God-Father, Son, or Holy Spirit—reveal of himself?
- · What insight am I given into myself, and into my life situation? Is there an example or a warning to heed? A promise to claim?
- What does Christ require of me now, in thought, word, or action?

Then complete your meditation by reading the SU Bible study guide. In light of these insights from your fellow Christians, think further about what God is saying to you.




